In Cross River State, 79,000 people have been displaced by natural disasters in the past 9 months of which about 49,000 were displaced by the flood as a result of the release of water from the Lagdo Dam in Cameroun. The communities most affected are Biase, Ikom, Ogoja and Odukpani local government areas. Some houses in Calabar municipal have collapsed because of erosion. All these have led to the displacement of families and loss of lives.

The Cross River State Government, the Ministry of Health, Information and UNICEF are already helping, and I am calling on all Efik sons and daughters in the USA to join us in a used clothes and shoes drive. These items will be shipped to Nigeria for distribution to Biase (most affected), Odukpani and Calabar Municipal local government areas.
