I wish to sincerely thank you and the Efik National Association for all the items you donated in support of the 2013 Akamkpa/Biase Health Fair. I cannot thank you enough for taking on the extra trouble of transporting the items to the palace of the Obong of Calabar. On January 25th, 2013, a representative of Hon. Dan Asuquo and I collected all seven drums of supplies including clothes, shoes, medicines and two big bags of mosquito nets from the Obong's palace.

That same day I handed over some of the medical items to the General Hospital, Akamkpa where patients operated during the health fair for free (because they were too poor to afford it) were being cared for.

One container of supplies was donated to refugees in Adim, Biase Local Government Area. These people were displaced by the recent communal conflict between Adadama in Cross River State and Ikwo in Ebonyi State. They had lost everything but the clothes on their bodies. You should have seen the joy on their faces when the items were handed over to them at the Assemblies of God Church, Adim.
